Annexure-1**A) Action taken by Urban Local Bodies Department w.r.t Plastic Waste Management Compliance of Rule 6 of Plastic Waste Management (Amendment) Rules, 2018.**

Under the notification no 2/8/2013/R issued in the official Gazette of Haryana Govt. vide dated 20th August 2013, complete plastic ban has been enforced in the whole State. For plastic waste (including other dry waste) segregation 416 Material Recovery Facilities in 54 ULBs have been set up in the whole State. Apart from Material recovery Facilities, ULBs have also identified 4274 rag pickers and Kabariwalas's and registered 3232 for collection and segregation of plastic waste. These rag pickers are also segregating the plastic waste on their own level and selling it to the recyclers directly.

Further, directions have also been issued to all the ULBs vide letter memo no. XEN/DGULB/2020/2684 dated 12.08.2020 to start intensive drive for the enforcement of ban on the single use plastic waste along with seizing of plastic waste and imposition of penalty/fines on the violators. It has also been directed that for the recyclable Plastic waste, a proper mechanism for collection, segregation and processing of plastic waste as per the Plastic Waste Management Rules-2016 should be established. Also, the possibilities of use of the plastic waste in road construction should also be explored.

MC Gurugram has taken few following initiatives on Plastic Waste Management:

1. **Plastic to Roads project-** Approx. 27km road has been developed and approx. 690 Ton of plastic has been used till date.
2. **Plastic to tiles project-** Approx. 1.5 km road walking/jogging track has been developed at Jharasa Bundh and Approx.45 Ton plastic used is for interlocking paver tiles.
3. **Swap Plastic to grain project-** to remove the littered plastic on road side, MCG started initiative for collection via sanitation staff/ rag pickers and around 10 Ton waste plastic is collected via waste workers and grains has been provided to them under CSR project.
4. **Learning center at wazirabadhbundh-** MCG in collaboration with I am Gurugram has developed learning center for waste management under the name "Samadhan HUB" and collected appx 10 ton plastic and made installations from it for awareness to citizens for hazards of plastic, e-waste and other recyclables and additionally a Recycling corner has been developed at site and appx 700 kg to 1 ton dry waste (paper and plastic) is regularly collected and sent to Green-o-bin, KK plastic and Shyana for reuse. Appx 5000+ students has visited and learned waste segregation and composting at site. More than 1000 waste workers, kaamwali and mali has been trained for waste segregation. Appx 10000+ citizens have visited the site and are regular part of collection and awareness drive.
5. Four numbers of Plastic bottle collection machines installed at high foot fall area for collection and recycling
6. Appx 1500+ houses are collecting and segregating MLP, which is further, collected and stored by MCG and will be sent to PRO for final disposal.
7. It has a dedicated informal network for collection and recycling of Used Tetra Pak cartons (UTPC). There are 10 PET Collection centers, 5 UTPC Collection centers 5 big PET & 1 UTPC Accumulators in Gurugram. On an average 12-15 tons of UTPC is being collected in Gurugram. On an average 200 MT per month is collected and sent for recycling to Rajasthan and Delhi.
8. A trial road (length 200 meters) was laid in first week of December 2018 in Sector 5 Gurugram using waste plastic. Under this initiative, company purchased plastic waste at Rs. 6/ kg from the rag pickers. Looking at the success of this plastic road initiative, MC Gurugram notified that the plastic waste added in the hot mixture will be 8% of bituminous for the road construction
9. MC Gurugram is also setting up a buy back collection system through various Brand Owners under Extended Producers Responsibility. Various workshops and trainings have been conducted to train the sanitary workers and other related staff.

All the ULBs have been directed to replicate the same practice,.

Plastic Free Bhiwani Campaign.

- a) MC Bhiwani seized 25 Quintal plastic (equivalent to 12,50,000 bags) in last one year.
- b) MC Bhiwani enforced ban on the use of Plastic disposables items at Banquet & Party halls.
- c) MC Bhiwani also initiated use of Plastic Waste for constructing the roads. Planning underway to reuse 50% of the landfill's plastic underway.

MC Rohtak.

- a) Set up various cages around the city for dumping PET bottles which are collected and recycled by the operator.
- b) The Municipal Corporation has collaborated with private trusts that usually organizes Langar to function it without the usage of any kind of plastics to serve food. Instead reusable steel plates and other cutlery have been used.

Apart from the above-mentioned major campaigns, CSR initiatives have been utilized for making recyclable handmade bags, to limit the use of plastic bags. The challans are also being imposed on the violators as per provision of the Rules.

B) Action taken by Panchayat Department w.r.t Plastic Waste Management Compliance of Rule 7 of Plastic Waste Management (Amendment) Rules, 2018.

Sharamdaan activities for collection of plastic waste are being carried out on 2nd day of every month in all the Gram Panchayats. The Plastic waste is being collected & stored by all 938 Gram Panchayats. This collected waste is being sold to local purchase/ kabaddiwala. Further, in a meeting under the chairmanship of the Additional Chief Secretary, Public Works (B&R) Department, held on dated 09.07.2020, it was decided that PWD (B&R) will arrange to hand over the plastic waste to a vendor from Development & Panchayats Department and get it used in the construction of rural roads subject to the following conditions:-

- i) Each district will make available at-least 5 MT of plastic waste per month.
- ii) The minimum lot of collection of the waste plastic mix shall be 3.00 MT, that will be lifted by the vendor.
- iii) The vendor or his authorized representative will collect the plastic waste from designated places District or Block Headquarter in Haryana within 15 days after being intimated by Engineer, in the presence of concerned Block Development & Panchayat Officer (BDPO) of that area.
- iv) The payment will be made directly to State Project Coordinator, Haryana State Swachh Bharat Mission immediately after receipt of waste plastic from BDPO concerned
- v) The Block Development & Panchayat Officer (BDPO) shall inform and request the Engineer of PWD (B&R) concerned to place an order with the vendor when a minimum of 3MT waste plastic is collected in his area. Block Development & Panchayat Officer (BDPO) will also inform State Project Coordinator, Haryana State Swachh Bharat Mission after the plastic is collected from his area.
- vi) The waste plastic would be collected at a fixed rate of Rs. 8 Per Kg.

Accordingly, vide this department letter no.HSSBM-SPM-2019/63842-64047 dated 16.07.2020, the necessary instructions have already been issued to all the Deputy Commissioners, Additional Deputy Commissioners, DDPOs, BDPOs in the State as under:-

1. The concerned ADC shall be responsible to ensure that at-least 5 MT plastic waste is collected per district per month and hand it over to the authorised vendor of PWD (B&R) Department.
2. All the BDPOs are designated as Nodal Officers for this purpose. They will be responsible to hand over the plastic waste to the vendor engaged by PWD (B&R), Department.
3. The BDPOs will be responsible to get the waste plastic transported at designated place, so that minimum 3MT plastic waste can be made available at a single site.
4. The SBM-G Team will ensure awareness activities on segregation of plastic waste at household level in the rural areas and ensure organization of Shramdaan activity on 2nd of every month for collection of plastic waste.
