## Order

Whereas the Board had issued procedure for consent management under Water Act, 1974, Air Act, 1981 and for authorization under Hazardous Waste (MH&TM) Rules, 2008 vide Endst. No. 10195-10218 dated 07.03.2014 which was published in the gazette on 15.04.2014 wherein the period of validity of consent to Establish (CTE) was specified depending upon the category of the projects.

Whereas the Ministry of Environment & Forest and Climate Change (MoEF & CC) vide Notification No. S.O.1141 (E) dated 29.04.2015 had extended the period of Environment Clearance (EC) from 5 years to 7 years in the case of construction and area development projects and all other projects & activities.

Whereas the state business action plan issued by Department of Industrial Policy & Promotion (DIPP) envisages for issue of consent to establish for a minimum period of 5 years or more to implement the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Policy, 2015 for ease of doing business by the Industries.

Whereas the validity period in CTE in view of extension of environmental Clearance from 5 years to 7 years was examined by TAC in its meeting held on 03.12.2015 and subsequently on 22.01.2016 and the proceedings of the same were circulated vide this office letter no. HSPCB/PLG/2016/5076-88 dated 28.01.2016 after approval of Competent Authority.

The TAC (Policy) had recommended for the following amendments in the consent Policy order issued vide Endst. No. 10195-10218 dated 07.03.2014 and published in the gazette on 15.04.2014:-

1. The period of CTE for projects requiring Environmental Clearance be granted upto 07 years or the date of commissioning, whichever is earlier subject to the validity of EC.
2. The period of CTE for projects not requiring Environmental Clearance be extended from 02 years to 05 years including stone crushers, hot mix plants, screening plants, brick kilns etc.

In view of above, it is hereby ordered that the following amendments are made in the consent policy orders issued vide Endst. No. 10195-10218 dated 07.03.2014 and published in the gazette on 15.04.2014:-

- i. The period of CTE for projects requiring Environmental Clearance be granted upto 07 years or the date of commissioning, whichever is earlier subject to the validity of Environment Clearance.
- ii. The period of CTE for projects not requiring Environmental Clearance be extended from 02 years to 05 years including stone crushers, hot mix plants, screening plants, brick kilns etc.

These orders shall come into force with immediate effect.
