If the offence is committed, that cannot be sought to be exempted. Every day fly ash is being generated on account of huge quantity of use of coal for generating electricity and that adversely affect the health of the people. Therefore, utmost care is required to be taken to see that the fly ash is stored/utilised in such a manner that it does not adversely affect citizens. All the State Governments. State Electricity Boards. State Pollution Control Boards are required to take action in the matter pending before the court. That is not done. It is the duty of the Pollution Control Board to take immediate action in the matter rather wasting time. All generating units, and particularly NTPC must file an affidavit with regard to all its units engaged in generation of the electricity giving details of their action plan, if by the time they have not submitted to the Union of India and the Court.
