ORDER

The Sub Committee on GRAP in its meeting held on 30.12.2021 observed that currently the Air Quality Index is in the poor category. It was also noted that moderate winds and no severe episodes are anticipated until January 05, 2022 and, AQI in Delhi-NCT is likely to remain in the Poor to lower end of Very Poor category.

In view of the above, the Sub-Committee decided to permit operation of Stone Crushers and Hot Mix Plants subject to strict adherence to environmental norms and guidelines, with valid consent to operate from the SPCB/PCC and taking due pollution prevention & control measures. This shall be subject to further review based on Delhi's air quality in the ensuing days.

Other actions as included in the Order no A-19014/45/CAQM-GRAP dated 13.11.2021 shall continue to remain in force.

All the concerned agencies must closely monitor, at appropriate levels, the action taken with respect to enforcement of GRAP action plan and submit daily report to the concerned SPCBs/ DPCC, CPCB and the Sub Committee.

Minutes of the 9th meeting of the Sub-committee for operationalization of Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP)

December 23, 2021

Ninth meeting of the Sub-committee on Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) was convened on December 23, 2021 via video conferencing. The meeting was chaired by Dr. Prashant Gargava, Member Secretary, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) and chairperson of the Sub-committee. The list of participants is annexed (Annexure I).

MS, CPCB welcomed the participants and requested Dr. V.K. Soni, IMD, for inputs on meteorological forecast. Dr. Soni informed that the calm/slow winds and poor ventilation conditions have led to the Very Poor/Severe air quality since December 21, 2021. The air quality over Delhi-NCT is likely to start improving from 24.12.2021 but remain in Very Poor category on December 24 and 25, 2021. The air quality is likely to improve significantly from 26th December onwards and AQI to reach in Poor/Moderate category on 27th December owing to relatively stronger winds and rainfall on 26th and 27th December. The wind is likely be coming from East direction of Delhi with wind speed 05-15 kmph for next 5 days.

The Sub-committee observed that measures for Severe AQI category are already in force, and, considering the meteorological forecast suggesting improvement in coming days, no additional measures are recommended. The agencies must ensure strict implementation of measures that are already in force.

Meeting ended with thanks to chair and from chair.

ORDER

In the wake of adverse air quality in NCR, the Commission through its various Orders under Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) including Direction No. 44 has directed for complete ban on the use of DG Sets, except for emergency purposes. The exceptions for operation of DG Sets for emergency purposes have been detailed out in the Sub-Committee on GRAP's Order No. A-19017/45/CAQM-GRAP/2020-21 dated 28 10 2021.

For the purpose of imparting further clarity in the matter, henceforth the following shall only be categorized as emergency purposes/services, for which DG Set operation shall be permitted as exception in NCR, whenever such orders for banning/stoppage of use of DG Sets are in force:

- Medical Services (Hospital/Nursing Home/Health care facilities) including units involved in manufacturing of life saving medical equipments/devices, drugs and medicines
- Elevators/Escalators/ travelators etc. in various installations
- Railway Services/Railway stations
- 4. Metro Rail Corporation Services, including trains and stations
- Airports and Inter-state Bus Terminals(ISBTs)
- Sewage Treatment Plants
- Water pumping Stations
- National Security/Defence related activities/Projects of national importance.

All Enforcement Agencies of NCR are requested to give wide publicity to this Order and ensure compliance of the Commission's directions accordingly.

In case, an activity/service other than those mentioned above warrants use of DG Sets, the agency concerned will approach the Commission with full justification for seeking its approval.

ORDER

Sub.: Implementation of Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) in Delhi-NCR- Steps to be taken

The air pollution levels in Delhi-NCR post-Diwali have been substantially high. It is due to the compounding impact of local sources, adverse meteorological conditions that restrict pollution dispersion, and regional contribution including stubble burning. A Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) was notified by the Government of India pursuant to the Hon'ble Supreme Court Order, dated December 02, 2016 in the matter of M. C. Mehta vs. Union of India. The GRAP provides specific set of actions depending on air pollution levels, which are to be implemented by identified agencies for minimizing the pollution, particularly during critical winter season.

The Sub-Committee of Commission for Air Quality Management in Delhi-NCR and Adjoining Areas (CAQM) for operationalizing GRAP has been regularly reviewing the air quality and meteorological information, and has issued directions vide Orders dated, October 18, 28 and November 03, 08, and 12 for implementation by concerned agencies. The agencies were also asked to send daily Action Taken Reports (ATR) to the CAQM and Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB).

The Sub-Committee, in its meeting held on November 12, 2021 observed that PM₁₀ and PM_{2.5} levels were beyond emergency threshold values of 500 μg/m³ and 300 μg/m³, respectively. As per GRAP, if the levels continue beyond threshold limit for 48hours or more, 'Emergency Measures' must be implemented. Therefore, in the Order, dated November 12, 2021, the concerned States and Agencies were asked to be in complete readiness for implementing 'Emergency Measures', in addition to various other measures. The current situation was reviewed again today by the Sub-Committee. It was observed that PM₁₀ and PM_{2.5} concentrations have come down below threshold values, however, it continues to remain in Severe AQI category.

In view of the above and as per decision of the Sub-Committee, following directions are issued for strict compliance:

- States and concerned Agencies must be in complete readiness for implementing "Emergency Measures" as listed under GRAP (https://epeb.nic.in/uploads/final_graded_table.pdf) in a short notice.
- Following actions as per earlier Orders of the Sub-Committee, shall be strictly implemented till further order:
 - a) Increase frequency of mechanized cleaning of road and sprinkling of water on roads. Identify road stretches with high dust generation.
 - Ensure that all brick kilns remain closed in Delhi-NCR as per the directions of Hon'ble NGT.
 - Ensure closure of all Hot Mix plants and Stone Crushers in Delhi-NCR.
 - d) Maximize generation of power from existing natural gas based plants to reduce operation of coal based power plants in the NCR (Badarpur power plant already shut down)
 - e) Intensify public transport services (bus and metro) by augmenting contract buses and increasing frequency of service. Introduce differential rates to encourage off-peak travel.
 - f) Regular inspection for strict enforcement of dust control measures must be ensured at construction sites and close non-compliant sites.
 - g) Ensure uninterrupted power supply to discourage the use of Generator sets.
 - h) Stop use of diesel generator sets (except for emergency purposes)
 - i) Enhance parking fee by 3-4 times
 - i) Stop use of coal/firewood in hotels and open cateries
 - k) Alert in newspapers/TV/ radio to advise people with respiratory and cardiac patients to avoid polluted areas and restrict outdoor movement.
 - Stringently enforce/stop garbage burning in landfills and other places and impose heavy fines on person responsible
 - m) Stringently enforce all pollution control regulations in industries and thermal power plants

- n) Strict vigilance and no tolerance for visible emissions stop plying of visibly polluting vehicles by impounding or heavy fine.
- o) Strict vigilance and enforcement of PUC norms.
- p) Deploy traffic police for smooth traffic flow at identified vulnerable areas
- q) Strictly enforce Hon'ble Supreme Court order on diversion of non-destined truck traffic and ensure only trucks registered after 2005 are allowed entry into Delhi.
- r) Strictly enforce Orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court and Hon'ble NGT regarding firecrackers.
- Government and private offices and other establishments are advised to reduce vehicle usage by at least 30% (by working from home, car-pooling, and optimizing their field activities, etc.)
- 4. People are advised to limit outdoor activities and minimize their exposure.
- All responsible agencies must closely monitor, at appropriate levels, the actions taken and submit daily report to concerned SPCBs /PCC, which will review and further submit reports to CAQM and CPCB.

This is in continuation to the Order No. A-19014/45/CAQM-GRAP/2020-21 of the Subcommittee, dated November 08, 2021.

The Sub-committee convened a meeting on November 12, 2021. Air quality status was reviewed; AQI was in 'Severe' category and exceeded the threshold limit of PM₁₀ (500μg/m³) and PM_{2.5} (300µg/m³) in Delhi-NCR on November 12, 2021 at 03.00 hours and 01.00 hours, respectively. It was also noted that meteorological conditions will be highly unfavorable for dispersion of pollutants till November 18, 2021 in view of low winds with calm conditions during the night.

Therefore, concerned States and Implementing Agencies must be in complete readiness for implementation of measures under 'Emergency' category as per GRAP. In addition, following should be implemented with immediate effect in Delhi-NCR-

- 1) All actions under 'Severe' category as per Order dated November 08, 2021 to be continued stringently with more rigour (copy enclosed for ready reference).
- 2) Government and private offices and other establishments are advised to reduce vehicle usage by at least 30% (by working from home, car-pooling, and optimizing their field activities, etc.).
- People are advised to limit outdoor activities and minimize their exposure.
- 4) Implementing agencies, at appropriate level, must closely monitor actions taken and submit daily report to concerned SPCBs /PCC, which will review and further submit reports to CAQM and CPCB.

Sub.: Implementation of Graded Response Action Plan in Delhi-NCR- steps to be taken

This is in continuation to the Order No. A-19014/45/CAQM-GRAP/2020-21 of the Sub-committee, dated October 28, 2021. The Sub-committee convened a meeting on November 08, 2021 and reviewed air quality status as well as meteorological and air pollution forecast. As per IMD's forecast, winds are expected to be North Westerly for the next 5 days which may possibly lead to high contribution of stubble burning. In addition, unfavorable meteorology may cause air quality to fluctuate between 'Severe' and higher end of 'Very Poor' category in the coming days.

Based on the decisions made by the Sub-committee, following actions are to be strictly enforced by concerned agencies:

- Actions under 'Severe' category, in addition to steps listed under 'Very Poor' and 'Poor' to 'Moderate' AQI categories (enclosed for ready reference) should be implemented with immediate effect in Delhi-NCR-
 - Increase frequency of mechanized cleaning of roadand sprinkling of water on roads. Identify road stretches with high dust generation.
 - b. Ensure that all brick kilns remain closed in Delhi-NCR as per the directions of Hon'ble NGT.
 - e. Ensure closure of all Hot Mix plants and Stone Crushers in Delhi-NCR.
 - d. Maximize generation of power from existing natural gas based plants to reduce operation of coal based power plants in the NCR (Badarpur power plant already shut down)
 - e. Intensify public transport services. Introduce differential rates to encourage off-peak travel.
- States to disseminate information about air pollution levels and for creating awareness among citizens regarding steps to minimize air pollution.
- Implementing agencies, at appropriate level, must closely monitor actions taken and submit daily report to concerned SPCBs /PCC, which will review and further submit reports to CAQM and CPCB.

Sub.: Implementation of Graded Response Action Plan in Delhi-NCR- steps to be taken

This is in continuation to the Order No. A-10014/45/CAQM-GRAP/2020-21 of the Sub-committee dated October 18, 2021. The Sub-committee convened a meeting on October 28, 2021 and reviewed air quality status as well as meteorological and air pollution forecast,made available by fMD. It was noted that winds are North-Westerly until the morning of November 01, 2021. Further minimum temperature is likely to drop to 14-15°C with increased moisture, which is unfavorable for dispersion of pollutants. It is likely that air quality may fall in 'Very Poor' AQI category.

Based on the decisions made by the Sub-committee, the following actions are to be strictly enforced by concerned agencies:

- Following actions under "Very Poor" eategory, in addition to steps listed under "Poor" to "Moderate" AQI category should be implemented with immediate effect in Delhi-NCR:
 - Mechanical/vacuum-based sweeping of roads to be earried out daily.
 - b. Ensure water sprinkling along with use of dust suppressants (at least every alternate day) on roads to arrest road dust especially at hotspots, heavy traffic corridors, vulnerable areas (before peak hours) and proper disposal of dust collected in designated sites/landfills.
 - Regular inspection for strict enforcement of dust control measures must be ensured at construction sites.
 - d. Ensure uninterrupted power supply to discounage the use of Generator sets.

 - Stringently enforce/stop garbage burning in landfills and other places and impose heavy fines on person responsible.
 - Stringently enforce all pollution control regulations in industries and thermal power plants.
 - Ensure that all brick kilns remain closed in Delhi-NCR as per the directions of Hon'ble NGT.
 - d. Ensure periodic mechanized sweeping and/or water sprinkling on roads with heavy traffic and dust generation potential.
 - Strict vigilance and no tolerance for visible emissions stop plying of visibly polluting vehicles by impounding or heavy fine.
 - f. Strict vigilance and enforcement of PUC norms.
 - Stringently enforce rules for dust control in construction activities and close non-compliant sites.
 - h. Deploy traffic police for smooth traffic flow at identified vulnerable areas.
 - Strictly enforce Hon'ble Supreme Court order on diversion of non destined truck traffic and ensure only trucks registered after 2005 are allowed entry into Delhi.
 - Strictly enforce orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court and Hon'ble NGT regarding firecrackers.
- Implementing agencies should be in readiness for implementation of actions under 'Very Poor' category.
 - Citizens to take steps to check air polluting activities, such as:
 - Keeping PUC certificates up to date.
 - Keeping engines of cars / bikes / scooter properly tuned.

- Maintaining proper air pressure in tires of cars, bike, scooters.
- d. Adherence to land driving.
- e. Optimize use of private vehicles.
- f. Not disposing waste / garbage in the open spaces.
- g. Reporting air pollution activities through SAMEER App, social media platforms and other public grievance portals
- States / implementing agencies to disseminate information about air pollution levels and steps to minimize air pollution, for creating awareness among citizens.

In view of the above, you are hereby advised to implement the directions of CPCB and to ensure strict compliance during the period. Action taken report on the above directions may also be submitted at the earliest please.

ORDER

Sub.: Implementation of Graded Response Action Plan in Delhi-NCR- steps to be taken

The Commission for Air Quality Management in NCR and Adjoining Areas, constituted a Sub-committee for operationalization of Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) and issuing necessary orders to the effect, vide order dated October 14, 2021 (Copy enclosed for ready reference).

The Sub-committee held two meetings on October 12 & 18, 2021 and reviewed air quality status as well as meteorological and air pollution forecast, made available by IMD. It was noted that air quality was in the 'Satisfactory' AQI category. North-Easterly winds with speed of 10-12 Km/hr will prevail till October 20, 2021 thereafter, winds will become North-Westerly with speed of 8-10 Km/hr. In the period between 21st to 24st October, air quality is likely to fluctuate between 'Moderate' to 'Poor' AQI categories.

Based on the decisions made by the Sub-committee, the following actions are to be implemented by concerned agencies with immediate effect:

- 1. Actions under 'Poor' to 'Moderate' category-
 - a) Stringently enforce/stop garbage burning in landfills and other places and impose heavy fines on person responsible
 - Stringently enforce all pollution control regulations in industries and thermal power plants
 - Ensure that all brick kilns remain closed in Delhi-NCR as per the directions of Hon'ble NGT.
 - d) Ensure periodic mechanized sweeping and/or water sprinkling on roads with heavy traffic and dust generation potential.
 - e) Strict vigilance and no tolerance for visible emissions stop plying of visibly polluting vehicles by impounding or heavy fine.
 - f) Strict vigilance and enforcement of PUC norms.



- g) Stringently enforce rules for dust control in construction activities and close non-compliant sites.
- h) Deploy traffic police for smooth traffic flow at identified vulnerable areas
- Strictly enforce Hon'ble Supreme Court order on diversion of non-destined truck traffic and ensure only trucks registered after 2005 are allowed entry into Delhi.
- Strictly enforce orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court and Hon'ble NGT regarding firecrackers.
- Implementing agencies should be in readiness for implementation of actions under *Very Poor* category.
- 3. Citizens to take steps to check air polluting activities, such as:
 - a) Keeping PUC certificates up to date.
 - b) Keeping engines of ears/ bikes/ scooters properly tuned.
 - e) Maintaining proper air pressure in tires of cars/ bikes/ scooters
 - d) Adherence to lane driving
 - e) Optimize use of private vehicles
 - f) Not disposing waste /garbage in the open spaces
 - g) Reporting air pollution activities through SAMEER App, social media platforms and other public grievance portals
- States/Implementing agencies to disseminate information about air pollution levels and steps to minimize air pollution, for creating awareness among citizens.

All the concerned agencies must take steps as mentioned above and submit action taken report to the Member Secretary, CAQM.
