Sh. Nitin Mehta, Regional Officer, HSPCB, Ambala Region, welcomed the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Ambala, other Officers and general public present in the hearing. He explained about the necessity of the public hearing being held under provision of EIA notification of 2006, amended to date. He detailed about the requirement for obtaining Environmental Clearance under the EIA notification from MoEF, Govt. of India. He particularly emphasized that those present in the hearing should raise their queries/suggestion/objection regarding any problem which may crop after commissioning of this project. He added that Haryana State Pollution Control Board is bound to implement Environmental Laws i.e. Water Act, 1974/ Air Act, 1981/ EP Act, 1986.

Further, formal permission to start the process of public hearing was granted by the Chairman Sh. Sachin Gupta IAS, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Ambala.

Thereafter Sh. Nitin Mehta, Regional Officer, HSPCB, Ambala Region requested Sh. Navneet, Project proponent consultant to give the presentation of the project in detail and remedies taken by the project proponent to control the environmental impacts which may arise after expansion of the existing project.

Sh. Navneet (Environment Consultant of Project Proponent) welcomed the participants and began the presentation. He explained about the Construction of 6 lane access Controlled Greenfield Highway of Shamli-Ambala Sec. from Ch. 0+000 to Ch. 120+970. (Total length: 120.970 km) under Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase II (Lot-9/package-I) in the State of Haryana- at Community Centre, Village Tepla, Distt. Ambala. The Environmental consultant also detailed about the project regarding project location, Description of the project, Baseline monitoring results of air, water, noise and soil, Air and Noise Quality Control, Greenbelt/plantation development.





As there were no more queries, the Chairman, Sh. Sachin Gupta IAS, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Ambala closed the public hearing for this project.
