ORDER

Whereas the Government of India, Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion, Ministry of Commerce & Industries, has laid emphasis on "Ease of Doing Business" for providing efficient, convenient, transparent and integrated electronic services to the applicants.

Whereas the Industries & Commerce Department Haryana has notified Enterprises Promotion Policy-2015 vide notification no. 49/43/2015-4IB1 dated 14.08.2015. The policy envisages for simplification of procedure of consent management for the industries/projects.

Whereas the Board had issued Inspection Policy vide order Endst. No. HSPCB/PLG-142/2016/5371-95 dated 24.02.2016 to streamline and simplify the process of inspections of the units/industries.

As per provisions of Business Reforms Action Plan 2016 related to the Board, a system for computerized allocation of inspectors has to be designed and implemented.

In view of above the allocation of inspectors for inspection of industries/projects for implementation of various Environmental Laws /Pules may be done as heleville.
