## Office Order

Whereas, inspection policy was circulated vide Head Office order Endst. No. HSPCB/PLG-142/2016/5371-95 dated 24.02.2016 wherein the periodicity for inspection/sampling of the industries/projects covered under Red and Orange categories was prescribed under Para no. 4.2.4;

Whereas, after coverage of Green Category of the industries/projects under consent management, the periodicity for inspection/sampling of Green category of industries/projects for mandatory inspection was prescribed for 07 years vide order Endst. No. HSPCB/2017/3145-3170 dated 07.03.2017 in partial modification/amendment in the Para no. 4.2.4 of the above said inspection policy of the Board;

Whereas, Green category of industries/projects were exempted from mandatory inspection vide Head Office Order Endst. No. HSPCB/2017/5635 dated 26.10.2017, which have a history of satisfactory compliance of environmental laws and prescribed norms of last 10 years or last 03 consecutive inspections arising either from mandatory inspection or any kind of other inspections conducted by the Board officials or which have installed the online monitoring system for effluents/air emissions showing compliance of prescribed standards, are exempted from environmental compliance inspection, subject to submission of self certification on yearly basis in lieu of conducting physical inspection regarding satisfactory compliance of environmental laws and prescribed norms.

Whereas Hon'ble NGT in its order dated 08.03.2019 passed in the matter of O.A. No. 639/2018 with O.A. No. 624/2018 titled as Shailesh Singh V/s State of Haryana & Ors. with Gaurav Jain V/s State of Haryana & Ors. has observed in para no. 4 of the above said order that the inspection policy of the HSPCB hardly matches the mandate of precautionary sustainable development principles of environmental law and further the auto renewal policy results in pollution remaining unchecked and directed that the above policy must be revised forth with by the HSPCB in consultation with CPCB.

Whereas a meeting was held in this regard at Chief Secretary level on 29.05.2019 and as directed by Chief Secretary, a subsequent meeting was held by HSPCB with Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) on 25.07.2019. Thereafter, a meeting at Chief Secretary Level was again held on 19.08.2019 to discuss the outcome of the meeting held with CPCB.

Whereas, CS Haryana has filed compliance report before Hon'ble NGT on 10.10.2019 wherein at Sr. No. 2(A) of the said report following provisions of increase in frequency of inspections of various industrial

sectors/projects has been indicated:-
