No. G.S.R. 90/CA6/74/S. 64/97.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 64 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 (Parliament Act 6 of 1974), the Governor of Haryana, after consulting the Haryana State Board for the Prevention and Control of Water Pollution, hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Haryana (Prevention and Control of Water Pollution) Rules, 1978, namely:—

- 1. These rules may be called the Haryana (Prevention and Control) of Water Pollution) First Amendment Rules, 1997.
- 2. In the Haryana (Prevention and Control of Water Pollution) Rules, 1978, in rules 22, in sub-rule (1) for item, A, B, C, and D and entires thereunder, the following items and entries thereunder shall be substituted, namely:—

No. 12/17/2002-Env.-III – In compliance with the judgment of the Punjab and Haryana High Court Order dated the 20th March, 2002, in Civil Writ Petition No. 19911 of 2001 M/s Balbir Singh & Co. V/s State of Haryana and others, and in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (1) read with Sub-section (2) of Section 54 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 (Act 14 of 1981), and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Haryana Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Rules, 1983, namely:-

- 1. (i) These rules may be called the Haryana Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution)
 Amendment Rules, 2002.
 - (ii) They shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 5th Dec, 1997.
- 2. In the Haryana Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Rules, 1983, in rule 15, in subrule (2), in the table under columns 1 and 2, for item A-VII (i) and (ii) and entries thereunder, the following items and entries thereunder shall be substituted, namely:-
