Notification

The 30th December, 2002;

No. S.O.106/C.A.6/1974/S.24/2002.- Whereas subsection (I) of section 24 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 (Central Act 6 of 1974). Puts prothibition on a person not to cause or permit any poisonous. Noxious of polluting matter determined in accordance with such standards as may be laid down by the State Pollution Board to enter (whether directly or indirectly ) into any stream or well or sewer or on land;

And whereas ,the prohibition contained in sub-section (I) of section 24 of notification No. S.O.83/C.A.6/1974/S.24/2002, dated the 20th July,2000 the persons establishing or taking steps to establish Information Technology Software Industries and person establishing or taking steps to establish Information Technology Hardware Industries (except those having electroplating heat treatment and painting processes) exempted from the consent management provided that where the number of workers in such industries exceeds 300 and there exists no sewerage facilities , no exemption shall be available.

And whereas, while amending information Technology Policy 2000 Information Technology Enabled Service was included within the definition/ scope of information technology industries in a new sub head titled Information Technology Enabled Services incorporating the following form category (M) in Annexure 2 titled, Categories of Industries in the scope/definition of Information Technology industry of the information Technology Policy2000

Information Technology Enabled Services

Information Technology Enabled Services are business processes and services the end products/ services of which are:-

- delivered outside Inida.
- Delivered over communication networks; and
- Either externally contracted (out-sourced ) or provided by a remote subsidiary of the same company (out- located).

And whereas, while issuing amended fnformation technology policy, the State Government observed that information technology Enabled services are not causing any water pollution and thereby deserves exempation from the provisions of the water (Prevention and Control of Pollution), Act,1974(Central Act,6 of 1974) along with information technology Software and Information Technology Hardware Industries,

And whereas the State Government is of the opinion that it is necessary and expedient to make amendment in Haryana Government ,Environment Department , notification No. S.O83/C.A.6/1974/S. 24/2000,DATED the 20th July,2000,for incorporating the information Technology Enabled Services;

Now therefore in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(3) of section 24 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution ) Act,1974 (Central act 6 of 1974), and all other powers enabling him in this behalf , the Government of Haryana on the recommendation of Haryana State Pollution Control Board hereby makes the following amendment in the Haryana Government, Environment Department notification S.O.83/C.A.6/1974/S.24/2000, dated the 20th July, 2000 namely:-
