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Office Order

Sub: Procedure for auto renewal of consent to operate under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981.

Whereas, HSPCB laid down the procedure for auto renewal of consent to operate under Water Act 1974 and Air Act 1981 vide office order endst no HSPCB/PLG-135/2019/2725 dated 17.12.2018 and subsequently amended vide office order endst no HSPCB/PLG-135/2019/411-434 dated 20.09.2019; and

Whereas, Hon'ble NGT vide order dated 05.11.2019 in matter of OA no 639/2018 titled as Shailesh Singh vs. State of Haryana observed that auto renewal cannot be done merely on pre-verification of documents and inspection is required; and

Whereas, the Government of India has taken steps to improve the Ease of Doing Business by constituting a Task Force and establishing a Deregulation Cell in the Cabinet Secretariat to systematically undertake deregulation, reduce the compliance burden, streamline and digitize systems, processes and information in all the States and Union Territories; and

Whereas, Task Force held a review meeting in the State of Haryana on 11.05.2025, wherein, the Task Force recommended several reforms to be undertaken by the state and one of the suggested way forward areas under the purview of Haryana State Pollution Control relates to renewal of consent to operate based on self certification and auto renewal facility as compared to the best practices of other States; and

Whereas, Central Pollution Control Board issued directions on 12.02.2025 regarding classification of different industrial sectors under Red, Orange, Green, Blue and White Categories and categorization is issued based on ranges of cumulative Pollution Index for different categories.

Therefore, in order to implement the recommendations of the Task Force, in supersession of procedure already issued vide endst. No. HSPCB/PLG-135/2019/411-434 dated 20.09.2019, the procedure attached herewith at Annexure-I shall be made applicable and implemented for Red, Orange, Green and Blue categories of industrial projects/units covered under consent management, for auto renewal of CTO under Water (P&CP) Act 1974 and Air (P&CP) Act 1981, based on self certification of industries/project proponent.

These orders shall be applicable on the applications received on or after 15.11.2025.

Annexure-I

<u>Procedure for Auto Renewal of Consent to Operate under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981</u>

- 1. The industrial units/projects falling under Red, Orange, Blue and Green Categories as per categorization of industrial sectors/projects issued by the Board for consent purpose vide order endst. No. HSPCB/PLG-135/2025/184-222 dated 01.08.2025 and amended from time to time, intending for auto renewal of the consent to operate (CTO) under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981 from the Board, shall apply through the online portal of the HEPC, at least 90 days before expiry of the validity period of previous CTO granted by the Board, on the format as per Annexure-A alongwith the requisite consent fees prescribed as per schedule to be deposited through online payment gateway and documents as mentioned in the Annexure-A.
- 2. No documents are allowed to be submitted manually.
- 3. Application shall be submitted by the authorized official of the unit, duly authorized by the owner/Board of directors / partners of the unit.
- 4. Only those units will be eligible for auto renewal of the CTO, which have valid CTO and there is no change in the raw material, manufacturing process, product, increase in overall capital investment cost on land, building, plant and machinery, production capacity and also in pollution load of these units as declared in the original application for obtaining previous CTO, no court case pending before any court of law/any judicial authority/appellate authority and no closure order including other proceeding under the provisions of Water Act, 1974 and under the provisions of Air Act, 1981 including non-payment of environment compensations.
- 5. The auto renewal of CTO will be valid only for those units which are complying the standards prescribed for discharge of pollutants prescribed under EP Rules, 1986 and submitted all required documents, prescribed consent fees and analysis report from NABL Accredited Laboratory.
- 6. On applying for auto renewal, the CTO will be renewed and generated automatically on the OCMMS without verifying the CTO fee, contents of the application and documents submitted by the unit by the concerned Regional Officer, on the format attached as **Annexure-B**.
- 7. The inspection of the unit may be carried out by the authorized officer (s) of the Board within 180 days of grant of such consent for verifying the correctness or otherwise of the particulars furnished in the application including verification of installation and adequacy of pollution control devices, CTO fee, pending cases before legal forum/tribunal/AA, pending environmental compensation and any other

proceeding under environmental acts. During the inspection, samples of effluent/ air emissions/ noise, as applicable may be collected in case sampling from the unit is required depending upon the process of the unit and get the samples analyzed from the Board's Laboratories as per policy of the Board. In case of any discrepancies /observations in the application or any other non compliance, the concerned RO shall convey the same to the unit and on receipt of reply from the unit, deal such type of cases as per policy of the Board and failing to complete the application may result in revocation/cancellation/withdrawal of CTO. The application of auto renewal of CTO will remain pending in account of RO for 180 days. The application will be closed by RO / Nodal officer HEPC/competent authority as per delegation of powers accordingly.

- 8. Auto renewal of consent to operate will not prevent the Board from taking coercive action against the unit including withdrawal/cancellation of the same in case the information provided by such unit are found false or incorrect and fails to comply with the applicable prescribed standards for discharge of environmental pollutants under EP Rules 1986 or any of the conditions of the consent so auto renewed or in case of violation of any provision of Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981.
- Auto renewal shall not be applicable to common facilities (e.g. CBWTF, TSDF, MSW, STP, CETP etc.), Such type of specific industries will be dealt as per normal procedure/guidelines.

- 5. The unit shall maintain the logbook for operation of ETP/STP/APCM for the record of energy and chemical consumption, quantity of effluent at inlet and outlet of ETP/STP supported with readings of magnetic flow meters alongwith quantity of treated effluent recycled/reused in the process, utilized in the premises and discharged, mode of disposal.
- 6. The unit shall install online continuous effluent/air emission monitoring system if required as per the direction of CPCB/HSPCB issued from time to time in this regard and will connect the same with the servers of the CPCB and HSPCB.
- 7. The unit shall apply for renewal of consent to operate atleast 90 days before the expiry of consent period.
- 8. The unit shall comply with all the conditions of renewal of consent to operate all the relevant provisions of Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981.
- 9.
