Minutes of Public Hearing held on 15.5.2023, at project site at Village - Kunda Kalan Block, Tehsil & District -Karnal, Haryana.

The Public Consultation (Hearing) was held as a mandatory requirement under EIA Notification dated 14.09.2006 and amended till date. Notice for public hearing was issued by the Member Secretary, Haryana Pollution Control Board Dated **15th April 2023**, wherein date of Public hearing was fixed as 15th May, 2023. Wide publicity was given to the public through newspapers (English Tribune and Hindi) and letters to the District Officers & Village Panchayats (**Copy of News cutting and notices are attached as Annexure- A**).

Accordingly public hearing was conducted on 15th May 2023 for Environment Clearance for - "Proposed Sand mining project having capacity of 18,00,000 TPA over an area of 42.70 ha located at Village -



Kunda Kalan Block, Tehsil & District -Karnal ,Haryana by M/s R.M. Industries Pvt Ltd").

Minutes of Public Hearing held on 15.5.2023, at project site at Village – Kunda Kalan Block, Tehsil & District -Karnal, Haryana". The public hearing was attended by the following officers (List attached as Annexure-B):-

At the very outset Sh. Shailender Arora, Regional Officer ,Haryana state Pollution Control Board ,Karnal Region welcomed Shri Aman Kumar , City Magistrate ,Karnal ,other officers of the District Administration and all the persons form the nearest Villages present in the public hearing .He then requested City Magistrate ,Karnal for permission to start the proceeding of the Public Hearing.

After obtaining the permission from the chair to start the proceedings of the Public Hearing ,Regional officer ,HSPCB Karnal Region briefed about the requirement of conducting Public hearing as per the provision of EIA notification 14.09.2006 for the proposed project of Mining of Sand capacity 18,00,000 TPA at Khasra over an area of 42.70 ha located at **Village –Kunda Kalan Block, Tehsil & District -Karnal ,Haryana** as the project falls under Schedule 1(a) Mining of Minerals under the schedule of EIA Notification ,2006 and categorization as category B.



The representative of EIA Consultant of M/s P and M Solution, Mr Rajesh Kumar Vishwas described the details of Proposed Project, which are as under:-

1. He informed that an application was filled by M/s R M Industries Pvt Ltd. with the SEIAA, Haryana for getting Environment Clearance under EIA Notification no 1533 (E) dated 14.09.2023 for the proposed Project of Mining of Sand Minor Minerals capacity 18,00,000 TPA over an area of 42.70 ha located at village Kunda Kalan, Tehsil - & District - Karnal, Haryana.
2. After considering the application of the PP, the SEIAA, Haryana has issued "Terms of Reference" to the project for preparation of the Draft EIA study report. Now, the proponent has submitted "Draft EIA report to HSPCB for conducting public hearing of the project as per the procedure prescribed in the EIA Notification dated 14.09.2006.
3. Following control measures will be taken by project proponent:
 - Road will be maintained in good condition by using local earth material.
 - Regular leveling of transportation route.
 - Sand mining will create temporary activity in the dry river bed, which will be replenished during monsoon.
 - The mining will not be carried out below the river water level.
 - Loaded vehicles will be covered with tarpaulin.
 - PUC certified vehicles will be used.
 - Overloading will be avoided.
 - Plantation will be carried out along the approach road and vicinity area.
 - Periodic air quality monitoring will be done and adequate measures will be done.



- Proper maintenance of vehicles will be done on regular basis.
- Necessary Personnel protective equipment will be provided to the workers.
- Adequate silencers will be provided in all the diesel engines of vehicles.
- Minimum use of horns and speed limit of 10km/hr in the village area.
- Plantation will be carried out along the approach road and vicinity area.
- Monitoring of water will be carried out periodically. Water analysis will be carried out seasonally.
- Regular monitoring of water levels and quality in the existing open wells and bore wells in the vicinity will be carried out.
- River streams will not be diverted to form inactive channels.
- Groundwater will not be intersected during mining activities.
- Mobile toilets will be made available near mine's office away from the river.
- Washing of vehicles in the river will be prohibited.
- Pollutant like dust, gaseous emanations will be minimized at the generation point itself and adequate measures will be taken to prevent their impact on environment.
- There is no forest in the core zone of mining lease area. So, there will be no deforestation due to mining.
- The mining lease area is devoid of vegetation. So, the greenery to be developed under green belt development programme in the village panchayat land and along the approach road will improve the floral environment of the area.
- No mining will be carried out during the monsoon season to minimize impact on aquatic life which is mainly breeding season.



- The lease area is not inhabited by any wild life, as there is no forest cover, hence there will not be any effect on migration or extinction of wildlife.

Project Proponent anticipated that the management will put all efforts to implement the suggestions given in EIA Report. There will not be any pollution problem from this mining. He then sought public opinion on the project and express willingness to clarify their queries. City Magistrate, Karnal asked the public to submit their queries/ suggestions.







ORDER

Brief facts of the case are that the present appeal has been filed by the appellant M/s R.M. Industries through Sh. Mohit Chhikara R/o Village Khairpur Bahadurgarh, Haryana offered the highest bid of Rs.22,98,00,000/- against reserve price of Rs. 06.53 Crore for obtaining a mining contract 'Kunda Kalan Block Sand Unit' over an area of 42.70 hectares (106.73 Acres) in District Karnal for a period of eight years. The highest bid was accepted and communicated through LoI dated 21.06.2022. As per terms and conditions of the auction notice the actual mining operations were to be allowed only after prior environmental clearance of competent authority as per requirement of EIA Notification dated 14.09.2006 of MoE&F & CC, Gol as amended from time to time. Further, the period of contract was to commence from the date of grant of environmental clearance or after 12 months from the date of issuance of LoI dated 13.03.2019, whichever is earlier.

2. Further the appellant was under obligation to execute the Contract Agreement on Form MC-1 appended to the Haryana Minor Mineral Concession, Stocking, Transportation of Minerals & Prevention of Illegal Mining Rules-2012 (in short the State Rules, 2012) within a period of 90 days from the date of issuance of LoI dated 21.06.2022. The stipulated period of 90 days has expired on



21.06.2022. As per clause 4.11 of the Letter of Intent, "in case of failure to execute the agreement, after issuance of this acceptance of bid/LoI within the prescribed period of 90 days, this LoI shall be deemed to have been revoked and 10% amount of the highest bid deposited as initial bid security shall be forfeited and they will be debarred from participation in any future auctions/tenders/competitive bidding process in respect of any area for obtaining mineral concession in the State for a period of 5 years."

3. The appellant has failed to execute the deed. So, the Director, Mines and Geology Department, Haryana vide orders dated 17.02.2023 revoked the LOI along with penal actions as per above.

4. In the interest of natural justice an opportunity of being heard has been given to the appellant on dated 25.05.2023 who was present there along with his counsel. On behalf of the Department concerned M.E made the submissions. During the course of arguments it was submitted by the appellant that it is not factually correct that the appellant was/is not interested in execution of contract agreement and to run the mining operations. In fact the appellant had been taking all the required necessary steps to obtain the prior EC and other approvals for mining. He also referred that the case of considering approval of Terms of Reference (TOR for preparation of EIA report was already listed before the SEIAA. The appellant had also taken steps for execution of deed and for the same, the necessary documents had also been prepared. It is stated that that LOI may please be restored and the appellant may be allowed to execute the contract agreement.

5. Dr. Madhvi Gupta, Mining Engineer present for the department stated that the department had no option but to take action as the appellant was not coming forward for submitting the papers for agreement. Had they come forward for execution of the agreement, the department would have executed the deed. The appellant being represented through his counsel undertook to do the needful at the earliest.

6. Dr. Madhvi Gupta, Mining Engineer stated that the delay in submissions of papers for agreement up to 30 days after the period of 90 days could have been condoned by the Director as per provisions of Rule 26(2) of the State Rules, 2012. The delay after the expiry of this period can only be condoned by the State.


I have heard rival contentions of both the parties and perused the record carefully, in view of the facts and circumstances mentioned above, order dated 17.02.2023 passed by Director, Mines & Geology Department seems to be justified considering the delegation made to him. However, considering the fact

that the appellant company is taking necessary steps in order to commence the mining operations and is interested in running the mine for the same period as mentioned in LOI and the fresh auction would cause financial implication on the State Exchequer as atleast one year free period will have to be given to new party even if the reauction is successful. Thus considering totality of facts and circumstances, the order dated 17.02.2023 is hereby set aside subject to the following conditions;

- (i) The appellant would execute the contract agreement within one month from the date of passing of this order;
- (ii) The time period of the contract would remain same as mentioned in LOI;
- (iii) The appellant would not make any default in making the payment of contract money or other dues required to be paid from time to time.

In case, the appellant fails to comply with any of the condition, the Director, Mines & Geology Department, Haryana may take fresh decision in accordance with law.
