At Village Usmapur, District Mohindergarh held on 05. 05.2022, 11.00 AM at site:-

The Public Hearing of M/s Astha Infra Developers Pvt. Ltd. for its proposed project stone along with associated minor minerals mine located Khasra No. 46 min was held on 05.05.2022 at Vill.-Usmapur, Distt.-Mohindergarh under the Chairmanship of Sh. Shyam Lal Poonia, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Mohindergarh.

The above mentioned proposed mining project pertains to opencast stone mining along with associated minerals on the total land measuring 33.10 Hectare on Khasra Nos. 46 min of Gair mumkin Pahar at Vill.-Usmapur. The project proponent is required to obtain the Environmental Clearance under EIA Notification of Ministry of Environment & Forest, Govt. of India, New Delhi dated 14.09.2006 & subsequently amended on 15.01.2016 for extraction of Minor Mineral and associated minerals.

The area of project is exceeding 25 Hectare but less than 50 Hectare, this Project falls under Category B1 and requires Public Hearing. The Environment Clearance of this project is to be given by SEIAA/SEAC, Panchkula, Haryana. In this regard an advertisement for conducting Public Hearing was published in local News paper in Dainik Jagran, in Hindi and also In National Newspaper in English on dated 17.03.2022. Copies of Executive summary of the project were also distributed to the persons and officers present at site during Public Hearing and presentation was given to the audience by M/s Sathi Planners Pvt. Ltd. Lake Avenue, Kanke Road, Ranchi on behalf of the Project Proponent.

The minutes of the Public Hearing are as under:-

At the very outset of Public Hearing Sh. Dinesh Yadav, Regional Officer, Haryana State Pollution Control Board, Dharuhera Region welcomed Sh. Sh. Shyam Lal Poonia, Deputy Commissioner, Mohindergarh also informed the public present at site in detail about this project and invited the suggestions/comments and objections of the public, if any so that the same can be recorded and forwarded to





- 3 The project Proponent will follow all the provision of Law/Act, EIA Notification dated 14.09.2006 & as amended on 15.01.2016 and all other applicable mandates of the Govt./Board/Hon'ble Courts issued time to time.
- 4 The project proponent will strictly comply all the conditions of TOR (Terms of Reference) of the respective authority besides compliance of all other applicable mandates.



- 5 Project proponent will strictly adhered to all commitments committed and submit required clearance as referred during public hearing.
