**Proceeding of the Public Hearing under the provision of EIA notification 2006 (as amended) for M/s Fylfot Geoworks Private Limited, Village Patvi, Tehsil Sahazadpur, District Ambala for proposed project of 100 KLD Grain Based Distillery with ZLD alongwith 4.0 MW Cogeneration Power Plant under the Chairmanship of Sh. Sachin Gupta IAS, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Ambala.**

The Public hearing was held as a mandatory requirement under EIA notification dated 14.09.2006 as amended till date for the said project. Public notice was got published by Haryana State Pollution Control Board Panchkula in newspapers to conduct public hearing for Environmental Clearance of the project scheduled on 30.11.2022.

**PROJECT – Fylfot Geoworks Private Limited, Village Patvi, Tehsil Sahazadpur, Mouli, District Ambala for proposed project of 100 KLD Grain Based Distillery with ZLD alongwith 4.0 MW Cogeneration Power Plant at Village Patvi, Tehsil Sahazadpur, District Ambala.**

**Date & Time:** 30.11.2022, 11:00 AM.

**Venue:** Site of the proposed unit at Village Patvi, Tehsil Sahazadpur, District Ambala.

All the people of the concerned area of District Ambala were informed through Public notice in Newspapers and Public announcements to attend this hearing.

Sh. Sachin Gupta IAS, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Ambala presided over this public hearing held on 30.11.2022 at site of the unit. The attendance of officers present from various departments and the residents of nearby villages is given at **Annexure-'A'**.

Besides Govt. Officers/officials of the District Administration, residents from the nearby villages attended the hearing at site of the proposed unit.

Videography and Photographs prepared during the hearing are enclosed herewith as **Annexure-'B'**.

Sh. Nitin Mehta, Regional Officer, HSPCB, Ambala Region, welcomed the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Ambala, other Officers and general public present in the hearing. He explained about the necessity of the public hearing being held under provision of EIA




notification of 2006, amended to date. He detailed about the requirement for obtaining Environmental Clearance under the provisions of EIA notification from MoEF, Govt. of India. He particularly emphasized that those present in the hearing should raise their queries/suggestion/objection regarding any problem which may crop after commissioning of this project. He added that Haryana State Pollution Control Board is bound to implement Environmental Laws i.e. Water Act, 1974/ Air Act, 1981/ EP Act, 1986.

Further, formal permission to start the process of public hearing was granted by the Chairman Sh. Sachin Gupta IAS, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Ambala.

Thereafter Sh. Nitin Mehta, Regional Officer, HSPCB, Ambala Region requested the Project proponent to give the presentation of the project in detail and remedies taken by the project proponent to control the environmental impacts which may arise after establishment of the project.

Dr. Yati Kachhawa, the Consultant of Project Proponent welcomed the participants and began the presentation. He explained about the project regarding project location, description of the project, Baseline monitoring data of air, water, noise and soil, Air and Noise Quality Control, Greenbelt/plantation development.

After the presentation, Sh. Sachin Gupta IAS, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Ambala requested the public to raise their suggestions, objections, views, queries and doubts which may arise from the project. He also informed the public that their queries/suggestions will be noted and forwarded to the authorities.

Thereafter, the following queries were raised by the public:

Sr. No.	Name and address	Query	Reply
1.	Sh. Varinder Singh (Sarpanch), Village-Jatwar.	He asked about the Employment, Village Development, Air, Water, Noise Pollution, Effects on agriculture due to industry and management Fly-ash.  Then RO, HSPCB asked the Project Proponent to also inform about the fuel to be used and steps taken to control fly ash and air emission.	Project Proponent replied that there will be no effect on farming due to the industry as the industry will work on advanced technology and machinery which will cause no harm to surroundings and the ash generated from the unit will be collected. Also Pollution control devices will be installed as per the prescribed guidelines and there will be no discharge of effluent outside the premises. The employment will be provided to the nearby people as per the required qualification and competency.


			Project Proponent also informed that village development activities such as Health Camps etc. will be done as per requirement.
2.	Sh. Nitin Mehta, RO HSPCB Ambala.	He asked about the waste water generation, its treatment and disposal details and area earmarked for installation of effluent treatment plant.	PP replied that the Industry will work on modern technology in which waste water generation is very less and ETP will be installed for treatment of effluent. The effluent treatment plant will also include Multi-Effect Evaporator and Dryer. DDGS will be used as cattle feed and sold to local traders. The treated water will also be recycled in the process. 28% of total area has been kept for installation of complete effluent treatment plant.
3.	Sh. Kuldeep Saini, Village Jatwar.	He asked about the Employment and Plantation.	Project Proponent replied that the employment will be provided to the nearby people as per the required qualification and competency.  33% of total area will be kept for plantation. CSR activities will also be done which will help in village development i.e Plantation, school development activities, Training activities, Health camps, Training to unemployed students of village etc.
4.	Sh. Nitin Mehta, RO HSPCB Ambala.	He asked about the sewage effluent generation, its treatment and disposal facilities.	Project Proponent replied that ZLD will be ensured through MEE & ETP followed by Reverse osmosis system. Environment Consultant replied that Domestic effluent treatment will be done through STP & treated water will be used for plantation.
5.	Sh. Sachin Gupta IAS, ADC, Ambala.	He again urged the public to raise their issues, if any related to this project.	


6.	Sh. Varinder Singh (Sarpanch), Village-Jatwar.	He asked about the water level decline due to overuse of borewell in industrial process.	PP replied that the industry will work on modern technology in which most of the water will be reused. Rain water harvesting structures will be provided to recharge ground water and borewells will not be used continuously as most of the water will be recycled in industrial process.
7.	Sh. Nitin Mehta, RO HSPCB Ambala.	He asked about the Fuel to be used, its storage, feeding system and measures to be taken to stop spreading to nearby fields.	Environment Consultant replied that Coal & Rice Husk will be used as fuel and stored in closed shed. Closed conveyer will be used for feeding of fuel.
8.	Sh. Sukhram, Sc.B, HSPCB, Ambala.	He asked about the R.O. reject and TDS.	Environment Consultant replied that ZLD will be ensured through MEE & ETP followed by Reverse osmosis system. Remaining salts will be sent to nearby TSDf site and water will be recycled/reused in process.
9.	Sh. Nitin Mehta, RO HSPCB Ambala.	He urged the public to raise their queries/ issues, if any related to Environment.	
10.	Sh. Varinder Singh (Sarpanch), Village-Jatwar.	He asked about the maintenance of the road and problems to be caused to the villagers due to transportation.	Environment Consultant replied that the speed limit will be maintained and vehicles will properly parked inside parking area. Metalled road will be constructed by the PP.
11.	Sh. Nitin Mehta, RO HSPCB Ambala.	He asked about mitigation measures for dust emissions due to Transportation and during construction activity.	Environment Consultant replied that water sprinkling will be done as per requirement and metalled road will be constructed. Modular STP will be installed for treatment of sewage generated during construction phase
12.	Sh. Nitin Mehta, RO HSPCB Ambala.	He again urged the public to raise the Environmental issues if any related to this project.	

12	Sh. Manjeet Singh (Sarpanch), Village-Patvi.	He asked about the employment.	Project Proponent replied that the employment will be provided to the nearby people as per the required qualification and competency.
