This is for the information of all the industries/project proponents that Industrial units/projects falling under Red, Orange and Green Categories of consent management of the Board as per order of categorization issued vide Endst. No. HSPCB/PLG/PLG-135/2016/546-572 dated 14.07.2016 and subsequent order Endst. No. HSPCB/2018/517-546 dated 26.02.2018(as amended), are required to be applied to this Board for obtaining consent to establish (CTE) and consent to operate (CTO) under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and for authorizations/registrations under various Waste Management Rules under Environment (Protections) Rules, 1986 through online portal of Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre (HEPC).

The Govt. of Haryana is aiming to eliminate the use of physical documents and enables the sharing of verified electronic documents across government agencies and also emphasising that Government's services are made available to citizens electronically to improve efficiency and transparency of services.
