Whereas, the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal issued order dated 16.1.2019 in the matter of OA No. 606 of 2018 titled Compliance of Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 and issued directions that,

"Every State may constitute a Special Task Force (STF) in every District with four Members one each nominated by District Magistrate, Superintendent of Police, Regional Officer of Haryana State Pollution Control Board and one person to be nominated by Chairman of the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA) for awareness on Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 by involving educational, religious and social organizations including local Eco Clubs."

Therefore, in compliance of the order dated 20.09.2018, the Special Task Force (STF) is hereby constituted comprising of the following persons

3	Nominee of Chairman of the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA)	Member

In pursuance of the same, the Deputy Commissioner of every district of Haryana has been directed to constitute a Special Task Force (STF) at District level with specific nominations as indicated above within a period of 7 days from the date of issue of this order with specific terms and conditions as envisaged in the directions of Hon'ble NGT in its order dated 16.1.2019, as below:

- The Special Task Force shall initiate steps to create awareness about the SWM Rules, 2016 by involving educational, religious and social organizations including eco clubs.
- The involvement of DLSA shall be subject to NLSA which is the apex body under the Legal Services Authority Act, 1987, by an appropriate administrative order.
- The STF shall involve the educational institution at every level in all the IEC activities.
- The STF shall identify and recommend action/appropriate environmental compensation against the polluters to the State Level Committee, applying the 'Polluter Pays' principle.

Further, the Deputy Commissioner of every district shall comply with the duties mandated under Rule 12 of SWM Rules 2016 and shall meet monthly and forward the report to State Urban Local Department, sending a copy to State Level Committee. The State Level Committee shall get the report from Deputy Commissioners once in a month.
