## Subject: Guidelines for Handling, Treatment, and Disposal of Waste Generated during Treatment/Diagnosis/Quarantine of COVID-19 Patients-Revision 2-reg.

Whereas, guidelines for Handling, Treatment, and Disposal of Waste Generated during Treatment/Diagnosis/Quarantine of COVID-19 Patients were issued on 18<sup>th</sup> March 2020 by the Central Pollution Control Board which are to be followed by every hospital, isolation centers, laboratories and common bio-medical waste treatment and disposal facilities. Copy of the same was circulated by Haryana State Pollution Control Board to all the Stockholders/concerned Vide letter No.HSPCB/HQ/SWM/2020/1243-84 dated 23/3/2020

Whereas, guidelines issued on 18.03.2020 for Handling, Treatment, and Disposal of Waste Generated during Treatment/Diagnosis/Quarantine of COVID-19 Patients were revised on 25.03.2020 wherein specific responsibilities/duties of Urban Local Bodies, State Pollution Control Boards/Pollution Control Committees and a person operating quarantine camps/quarantine home/Homecare, and Common Bio Medical Waste Treatment Facilities are defined. Copy of the revised guidelines was circulated by the Board Vide letter No.HSPCB/HQ/SWM/2020/1362-66 dated 28.03.2020 to all concerned departments/agency for compliance in the State of Haryana.

Now, the aforesaid guidelines for "Handling, Treatment, and Disposal of Waste Generated during Treatment/Diagnosis/Quarantine of COVID-19 Patients" has been again revised on 18<sup>th</sup> April 2020 to incorporate the specific requirements & responsibilities of persons operating sewage treatment plants at Healthcare Facilities and to clarify on management of general waste from quarantine homes and masks/gloves from other households.

In view of above, it is advised to strictly comply with the revised guidelines issued by CPCB on 19.04.2020 for Handling, Treatment, and Disposal of Waste Generated during Treatment/Diagnosis/Quarantine of COVID-19 Patients-Revision 2
