At the onset of Public Hearing, Nirmal Kumar, Regional Officer, Yamuna Nagar Region, Haryana State Pollution Control Board, welcomed the Chairperson Smt. Ranjit Kaur, H.C.S., Additional Deputy Commissioner, Yamuna Nagar and other Officers of the District Administration, Panches & Sarpanches of surrounding area and public present in the hearing.

Further formal permission to inaugurate the process of public hearing was granted by the Chairperson Smt. Ranjit Kaur, H.C.S., Additional Deputy Commissioner, Yamuna Nagar. The Regional Officer, HSPCB briefed about the necessity of the public hearing being held under provision of EIA notification of dated 14th September 2006, amended to date and submitted the present unit is

a formaldehyde manufacturing unit and covered at Sr. No. 5 (f) of the Scheduled of the EIA Notification 14.09.2006. He further submitted that the present unit already established for the capacity of 100 MT/Day and for this Consent to Establish (CTE) was granted by the Haryana State Pollution Control Board, but unit failed to obtain the desired Environment Clearance as per EIA Notification 14.09.2006 and consequently closure action under Environment Protection Act 1986 was taken against the unit.

Thereafter, Regional Officer, HSPCB requested project consultant to make the presentation for the project for information of all the people present.

Mr. Pawan Kumar Verma of VardanEnvironet has given the detailed presentation as under:

He informed that an application was filed by **M/s. Om Chem** with the MoEF&CC, New Delhi for getting Environmental Clearance under EIA notification no. 1533 (E) dated 14.9.2006 for Proposed Capacity Expansion in Formaldehyde Manufacturing Unit in Existing Facility from 100 TPD to 200 TPD at V.P.O. Kurali, Sabapur Road, Tehsil-BilaspurDistrict- Yamunanagar, Haryana.

After considering the application of the project, the MoEF&CC, New Delhi had issued 'Terms of Reference' to the project for preparation of draft EIA study report. Now, the proponent has submitted draft EIA report to the Haryana State Pollution Control Board for conducting public hearing of the project as per the procedure prescribed in the EIA Notification dated 14.09.2006.

Mr. Pawan Kumar Verma, Senior Manager, EIA of M/s VardanEnvironet, Environmental Consultant of the project proponent brought out the details of the project before the public. The following questions were raised:-


