

Proceedings of the Public Hearing for Project requiring clearance under Environmental Impact Assessment Notification, 14th September, 2006 (as amended) for Shifting of Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF) from village Kandela to village Shahpur, District Jind, by M/s Divya Waste Management Company on 29/11/2022 at 11:00 AM.

The above project is required to obtain Environmental Clearance as this project is covered under amended EIA Notification dated 14th September, 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forest, Govt. of India, New Delhi. The project proponent have applied for the Environmental Clearance to State Environment Assessment Corporation (SEAC), Haryana and requested to conduct a public hearing. In this regard, an advertisement regarding public hearing notice for publication in leading Hindi and English Newspapers were published by Haryana State Pollution Control Board on 21.10.2022. The public hearing was conducted on dated 29/11/2022 under the Chairmanship of Sh. Manoj Kumar, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Jind, Haryana and proceeded by Sh. Bhupinder Singh, Regional Officer, Haryana State Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Kaithal. The attendance sheets of the officers and general public who attended the above said hearing are enclosed as Annexure-A & B. The CDs of video graphs of the entire public hearing are enclosed as Annexure-C.

The following officers were present in the public hearing meeting.

- 2. Sh. Bhupinder Singh, Regional Officer, HSPCB, Kaithal
- 3. Sh. Vikash Kumar, JEE, HSPCB, Kaithal

Sh. Bhupinder Singh, Regional Officer, Haryana State pollution Control Board, Kaithal welcome the Deputy Commissioner, Jind with all other officers & general public present during the hearing and thereafter sought permission from the Chairman to start the Public Hearing. He briefed about the EIA notification dated 14.09.2006 and process of Public Hearing. He also requested the public to speak one by one and put up their question after the presentation of project and assured the public that their questions will be answered by the Project Proponents. Thereafter he asked the Project Proponent to give presentation of project. He informed to the general public that M/s Divya Waste Management Company who is already in operation at Village Kandela, District Jind has proposed to shift its plant to the village Shahpur District Jind. He further informed that M/s Divya Waste Management Company is a Common Biomedical Waste Treatment facility, catering hospitals of District Jind and District Sonipat. Thereafter, he invited the project proponent to briefly explain the details of the project.

Sh. Anand Dubey (EIA coordinator), Project Consultant, presented the case and explained about the proposed Common Bio Medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF) of the project as detailed below:

The Project Consultant has informed that the biomedical waste treatment facility is catering the disposal of human waste in an incinerator through burning at a temperature upto 1000°C to 1200°C/1400°C prescribed in the law. The height of chimney, air pollution control devices to control the pollution from such type of facility has been defined by Ministry of Environment & Climate Change, Govt. of India/CPCB/HSPCB. He has further informed the following compliances to be made in the proposed CBWTF shifting project:-

1. Chimney of minimum 30 meters height will be provided.

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- 2. The incinerator ash will be separated and will be disposed of through TSDF site.
- Incinerator will be provided with adequate Air Pollution Control Device like venturi scrubber which will trap all the gases and pollutants and the waste water will be recycled and reused.

He informed that this proposed project will be established in about 9 kanal land. He informed that M/s Divya Waste Management Company at village Kandela is already catering health care facilities of districts namely Jind and Sonipat. The proposed project at Shahpur will treat and dispose of the bio medical waste generated from about 600 health care facilities from the above said two districts. All the waste from Health Care Facilities (HCF) will be collected and disposed off as per BMW Rules, 2016. There is no receptor in the vicinity of proposed site which will be affected by establishment of proposed site. The school is also more than 500 meters from the proposed site. The particulate matter from the chimney will be settled before 300 meters. The water requirement will be met from ground water for which application will be submitted to Haryana Water Resources Authority for ground water extraction. A DG set of capacity 70 KVA will be required for operating the incinerator during power cuts. The approved fuel i.e. LSHS will be used in the incinerator as per directions of CAQM for NCR districts. The capacity of incinerator, autoclave and shredder will be 100 Kgs/hour, 30 Kgs/hour and 100 Kgs/hour respectively. The Effluent Treatment Plant of 4.5 KLD capacity will be installed at proposed project site. The requirement of manpower (about 9 to 10) will be met through the existing plant already operating at village Kandela and will be shifted to proposed project. No fresh recruitment is required in the proposed project. Shredder will be operated in a closed room for avoiding any noise pollution. The project cost will be about Rs. 110 lakhs and 2% (about Rs. 2.1 lakhs) cost of the total project will be spent under Corporate Environment Responsibility (CER) for welfare of public in nearby schools, plantations etc. Project does not fall under CSR as per relevant Act.

After the completion of Presentation by Project Consultant Regional Officer, HSPCB asked to raise their Queries/ suggestion by the officers and general public present during the hearing which are given as below:

Report regarding checking of compliance status of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 by Municipal Committee, Safidon, Distt.

In compliance of Govt. order conveyed vide memo No. DULB/NGT/Sect-VI/2022/6296-6309 dated 07.11.2022, the constituted committee members i.e. Chief Engineer. Municipal Corporation, Karnal, Sh. Satish Sharma, Executive Engineer-II, Municipal Corporation, Karnal, Sh. Vipin Kumar, AEE on behalf of R.O. HSPCB, Jind reached in the office of Municipal Committee Safidon, Distt. Jind on 29.11.2022 at 10:00 AM for checking of compliance status of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016. To conduct this inspection Secretary, Municipal Committee, Safidon was informed in advance vide this office letter No. 538/CE/MCK dated 25.11.2022 (Copy enclosed). Sh. Vikramjeet, Secretary (Addl. Charge) was not present there, Sh. Ajay Kumar J.E., Sh. Pardeep Sharma S.I. were present at the time of inspection. The constituted committee took the round of the city and visited the Solid waste dumping site. During inspection in the Safidon Town it is observed that sweeping job is being done well. The committee members did not find any GVP points in the city. The garbage collection points were cleaned, all garbage was lifted from the sites. The team members observed during site visit the job of sweeping and garbage collection and transportation is being done in good manner. The inspection report is as below in tabulated form:-

Conclusion: As on the date of inspection it is observed that SWM Rules, 2016 are being complied with partially. There is need of regular monitoring by Secretary, MC and President, MC intermittently. There is no clarity/record available, whether RDF collected by Rekart from the site is really given to JBM (waste to Energy Plant at Tajpur, Murthal) for scientifically end disposal or misused elsewhere. The compost generated till now from bio remediation is dumped on the low laying plot sites of the HSVP near to dumping site in sector-2 of HSVP. The inert collected from bio remediation is also dumped at the same site which get mixed with compost, whereas inert is required to be dumped in SLF site. There is no SLF site land with the MCS. The fresh waste is also dumped very near to legacy waste at same dumping site just across the road. The position is shown clearly in the photos. The photos of the dumping site is attached herewith. The fresh waste is being collected in mixed form.

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Suggestions :-

- Regular and strict monitoring of the work of legacy waste is required by higher authorities. It should not be left only on the part of J.E. & S.I.
- 2. There is need to manage scientifically end disposals of all fractions i.e. compost, RDF, inert and C&D waste coming out from bio remediation of legacy waste.
- 3. There is need to manage fresh waste being collected in mixed form instead of segregated form which can be managed through IEC activities, public participation, educative seminars with school children and students of colleges, involvement of RWAs and social workers etc.
- Construction of composting pits in parks for managing green waste and in schools, colleges or any other institutions for managing their green waste at source.
- Implementation of in house composting upon bulk waste generators to manage their wet waste at source.
- 6. Deployment of water tankers for suppressing dust pollution particularly on Asandh road and other major roads of the town (Jind Bye-pass road, Jind road).
- There is need to identify and earmark C&D waste site and to manage it under C&D Waste Management Rules, 2020.
- There is a need to identify and earmark at least 2 Acre land for setting up bio remediation treatment plant, wet composting/ bio mathenization plant on MCS owned land.

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
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
