The above project is required to obtain the Environmental Clearance as this project is covered under amended EIA Notification dated 14th September, 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forest, Govt. of India, New Delhi. The project proponent has applied for the Environmental Clearance to MoEF&CC, Government of India and requested to conduct a public hearing. In this regard, an advertisement regarding public hearing notice for publication in leading Hindi and English Newspaper was published by Haryana State Pollution Control Board (Annexure-A). The public hearing was conducted on dated 07/08/2023 under the Chairmanship of Sh. Swapnil Ravindra Patil, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Rewari, Haryana and along with other officers from respective departments. The attendance sheets of the officers and general public who attended the above said hearing are enclosed as Annexure-B&C. The Pen Driver of videography of the entire public hearing are enclosed as Annexure-D.

Sh. Vinod Kumar Balyan, Regional Officer, Haryana State pollution Control Board, Rewari welcomed the Chairman-cum-Additional Deputy Commissioner, Rewari with all other officers & general public present during the hearing and thereafter sought permission from the Chairman-cum-Additional Deputy Commissioner to start the Public Hearing. He briefed about the EIA notification dated 14.09.2006 and process of Public Hearing. He also requested the public to speak one by one and put up their question/suggestion/problem after the presentation of project and assured the public that their questions will be answered by the Project Proponent. Thereafter he asked the Project Proponent to give presentation of project.

Environmental Consultant Dr. Dharna Tiwari (EIA coordinator) presented the case and explained about the proposed Remediation and Reclamation of Existing Dumpsite, Rewari project as detailed below:

Municipal Council the "Authority" intends for Implementation of Remediation and Reclamation of Existing Dumpsite and construction, operation and maintenance of Sanitary Landfill at Village Ramsinghpura Rewari, Haryana. The proposed project is to manage the existing legacy waste via sanitary landfill, composting andMaterial Recovery Facility (MRF). This land where Bawal dumpsite is located is owned by Municipal Council, Rewari and has been used for open dumping of mixed MSW since the years. About 0.6 lakh tons of MSW has already been deposited at the Dumpsite. The main solid waste generation sources are residential, commercial and institutional establishments, vegetable and meat markets, hospitals, hotels and restaurants, and construction and demolition waste (debris). Total area of the project is 14.625 Acres and approx estimated expected project life is 1 year. Total Project Cost is 4.02 Crore. Under CER notification dated 1st May 2018, the Municipal Council shall spend 2% of its project cost, which comes Rs. 8 lakhs 4 thousands; this will fulfill public demand and bring overall improvement of the locality and shall be spent for overall development of the locality and local people. Some of the community developments plans shall also be considered by the Project Developer as part of corporate social responsibility.



श्रीमान जी,

सविनय निवेदन है कि हम निवासीगण ग्राम रामसिंहपुरा, ओढी, चान्दूवास, रसियावास, सांजरपुर, आनन्दपुर, साबन, आसरा का माजरा, जयसिंहपुर खेडा, मोहनपुर, बालावास, भैरामपुर मडंगी तहसील व खण्ड बावल जिला रेवाडी हरियाणा के रहने वाले हैं।

यह कि नगर पालिका रेवाडी व बावल द्वारा रामसिंहपुरा गांव में काफी सालों से कूडा डाला जा रहा है, इसके समाधान बारे हरियाणा राज्य प्रदूषण नियंत्रण विभाग रेवाडी द्वारा अपने कार्यालय का पत्र क्मांक HSPCB/1/168226/2023 Dated 05.07.2023 जारी किया गया, जिसमें श्रीमान स्पायुक्त महोदय रेवाडी को रामसिंहपुर डिम्पंग यार्ड की वजह से हो रही असुविधा, परेशानी व इसका समाधान करने बाबत जन सुनवाई दिनांक 07.08.2023 को मौके पर करने हेतू जारी किया गया। हम रामसिंहपुरा डिम्पंग यार्ड की वजह से होने वाले समस्याओं की ओर आपका ध्यान दिलवाने की कोशिश कर रहे है। यह कि लगभग आस—पास गांवो में 24,000 से अधिक आबादी है. यहां डाले जाने वाले कूडे से सब परेशान है तथा इस कूडे व गन्दगी की वजह से कैंसर मरीजों की संख्या दिन—प्रतिदिन बढती जा रही है, जिसका कारण कचरे में वनने वाली मीथेन गैस है, जिसकी वजह से 100 के आस—पास मृत्यु हो चकी है। कई बार हमने सरकार का ध्यान इस ओर दिलाने की कोशिश की, लेकिन कोई सुनवाई नहीं की गई। यह कि दिनांक 18 सितम्बर 2018 को उपायुक्त महोदय रेवाडी को ज्ञापन दिया तथा 2017 में उपमण्डल अधिकारी (ना.) बावल को भी ज्ञापन दिया नहीं की। रामसिंहपुरा डिम्पंग यार्ड में गन्द के साथ गौवंश भी यहां डाले था, लेकिन कोई सुनवाई नहीं की। रामसिंहपुरा डिम्पंग यार्ड में गन्द के साथ गौवंश भी यहां डाले गए, जिस पर ग्रामनिवासीयों द्वारा धरना भी दिया गया। लेकिन बलपूर्वक लोगों को हटा दिया गया। गए, जिस पर ग्रामनिवासीयों द्वारा धरना भी दिया गया। लेकिन बलपूर्वक लोगों को हटा दिया गया।

नगर पालिका द्वारा दिए गए मानक पूरी तरह गलत है, जिनका विवरण इस प्रकार है:-

- 2. ग्राम रामसिंहपुरा, रसियावास, ओढी का रिहायश क्षेत्र व बोरवैल व रसियावास, रामसिंहपुरा, ओढ़ी के सरकारी स्कूल लगभग 900 मीटर की दूरी पर है, लोगों का घरों में रहना, बच्चों का स्कूल में पढ़ने जाना दुभर हो गया है। स्कूल के बच्चे इस गन्दगी वजह से बीमार हो 信制
 - 3. कचरे से निकलने वाले Chemical खेतों में जाता है, जिससे फसल की गुणवत्ता व जमीन की उर्वरक क्षमता खत्म हो चुकी है, अगर ऐसे ही चलता रहा तो आस-पास की जमीन की र्व्वरक क्षमता खत्म हो जायेगी व भू जल-स्तर समाप्त हो जायेगा।

अतः आपसे निवेदन है कि इस पर संज्ञान लेते हुये शीघ्र समाधान करवाया जाये ताकि होने वाली भयंकर बीमारीयो, परेशानी से निजात मिल सके व हम सुखपूर्वक अपना जीवन-यापन कर सके। जनाब की अति कृपा होगी।
