#### Terms and conditions

1. The applicants shall maintain good house keeping both within factory and in the premises. All hose pipelines valves, storage tanks etc. shall be leak proof. In plant allowable pollutants levels, if specified by State Board should be met strictly.
2. The applicant/company shall comply with and carry out directive/orders issued by the Board in this consent order at all subsequent times without negligence of his /its part. The applicant/company shall be liable for such legal action against him as per provision of the

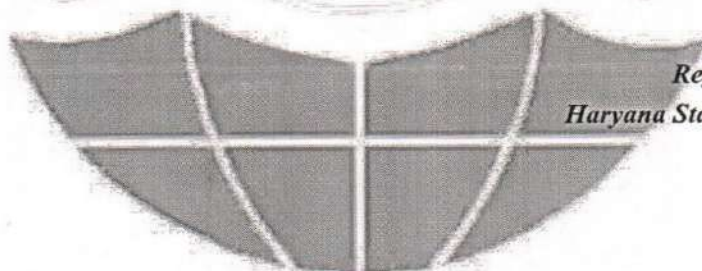
law/act in case of violation of any order/directives. Issued at any time and or non compliance of the terms and conditions of his consent order.

3. The applicant shall make an application for grant of consent at least 90 days before the date of expiry of this consent.
4. Necessary fee as prescribed for obtaining renewal consent shall be paid by the applicant alongwith the consent application.
5. If due to any technological improvement or otherwise this Board is of opinion that all or any of the conditions referred to above required variation (including the change of any control equipment either in whole or in part) this Board shall after giving the applicant an opportunity of being heard vary all or such condition and there upon the applicant shall be bound to comply with the conditions so varied.
6. The industry shall provide adequate arrangement for fighting the accidental leakages, discharge of any pollutants gas/liquids from the vessels, mechanical equipment etc. which are likely to cause environment pollution.
7. The industry shall comply noise pollution (Regulation and control) Rules, 2000.
8. The industry shall comply all the direction/Rules/Instructions as may be issued by the MOEF/CPCB/HSPCB from time to time.
9. The industry shall ensure that various characteristics of the effluents remain within the tolerance limits as specified in EPA Standard and as amended from time to time and at no time the concentration of any characteristics should exceed these limits for discharge.
10. The industry would immediately submit the revised application to the Board in the event of any change in the raw material in process, mode of treatment/discharge of effluent. In case of change of process at any stage during the consent period, the industry shall submit fresh consent application alongwith the consent to operate fee, if found due, which may be on any account and that shall be paid by the industry and the industry would immediately submit the consent application to the Board in the event of any change during the year in the raw material, quantity, quality of the effluent, mode of discharge, treatment facilities etc.
11. The officer/official of the Board shall reserve the right to access for the inspection of the industry in connection with the various process and the treatment facilities. The consent to operate is subject to review by the Board at any time.
12. Permissible limits for any pollutants mentioned in the consent to operate order should not exceed the concentration permitted in the effluent by the Board.
13. The industry shall pay the balance fee, in case it is found due from the industry at any time later on.
14. If the industry fails to adhere to any of the conditions of this consent to operate order, the consent to operate so granted shall automatically lapse.
15. If the industry is closed temporarily at its own, they shall inform the Board and obtain permission before restart of the unit.
16. The industry shall comply all the Directions/ Rules/Instructions issued from time to time by the Board.

#### Specific Conditions :

1. Unit will maintain ETP/APCM regularly and properly and maintain the Log Book for energy consumption of APCM and chemicals used daily for the ETP.
2. That the unit shall keep all the parameters within the prescribed limits and shall comply with all the Norms and Rules as prescribed in the Act.

3. That the unit will not discharge any untreated effluent inside and outside its premises.
4. That the unit will provide inter locking arrangement of DG set with STP/ETP/APCM and shall have separate D.G. set to ensure regular and effective running of pollution control devices and submit report in this regard to the board immediately
5. Unit will handover waste oil of D.G set only to the Authorized re-cycler of SPCB/PCC and submit annual report for the same online on the portal and also submit hazardous waste manifest online on the portal for haz waste generation from the process.
6. That the unit will not add any air polluting process/ machinery and also not to add any process which increases the pollution load.
7. Unit will apply for consent to operate for further period 90 days before expiry of this consent as per policy of Board.
8. That the unit will comply with all the provisions of Hazardous & other Waste Rules 2016 as amended .
9. Unit will comply the directions issued by MoEF & CC/ CPCB/ State Govt./ HSPCB from time to time.
10. The unit shall deposit the balance consent fees if any found due at any stage due to increase in the investment cost on Land. Building, Plant and Machinery of the unit at any later stage.
11. That the unit will apply separate application for authorization under HOWTM Rules, 2016 immediately as per the procedure available on the website of the board. .
12. Unit shall comply SOP guidelines issued by CPCB and submit compliance report with all the required documents within 7 days.
13. Unit will comply-with the Plastic Waste Management rules, 2016 for the plastic waste generated from the process and will obtain necessary authorization/registration for the same immediately as per the procedure available on the website of the board.
14. CTO so granted shall become invalid in case of violation of any of the above / any law of the land.

3. The person authorised shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous and other wastes except what is permitted through this authorization.
4. Any unauthorised change is personnel equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorised shall constitute a breach of this authorization.
5. The person authorised shall implement Emergency Response Procedure (ERP) for which this authorization is being granted considering all site specific possible scenarios such as spillages, leakages, fire etc. and their possible impacts and also carry out mock drill in this regard at regular interval of time.
6. The person authorised shall comply with the provisions outlined in the Central Pollution Control Board guidelines on "Implementing Liabilities for Environmental Damages due to Handling and Disposal of Hazardous Waste and Penalty".
7. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the State Pollution Control Board to close down the facility
8. The imported hazardous and other wastes, if any, shall be fully insured for transit as well as for any accidental occurrence and its clean-up operation
9. The record of consumption and fate of the imported hazardous and other waste, if any, shall be maintained
10. The hazardous waste including residue generated from the recycling process shall be disposed off as per the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016
11. In case of import of hazardous waste by the unit, the relevant provisions for import of the hazardous waste in the Hazardous and Other Waste (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 shall be complied with and the unit shall bear the cost of import or export and mitigation of damages if any.
12. An application for the renewal of an authorization shall be made 03 months before the expiry of such authorisation as laid down under these rules.
13.
