Relaxation in experience to Sh. Ramesh Kumar Ranga, Deputy Superintendent for promotion to the post of Superintendent

Sh. Ramesh Kumar Ranga, Deputy Superintendent, Haryana State Pollution Control Board has requested to promote him to the post of Superintendent by giving him relaxation in experience of 04 months.

Sh. Ramesh Kumar Ranga was appointed as Clerk in the Board on 26.09.1989. Thereafter he was promoted as Assistant on 09.12.2011 and further promoted to the post of Deputy Superintendent on 18.11.2019. He has acquired an experience of more than 08 years and 08 months as Assistant and Deputy Superintendent.

Presently, there are 04 posts of Superintendent are sanctioned in the Haryana State Pollution Control Board. All these posts are meant for promotion quota. Out of 04 posts, 03 posts are already filled up and one post is lying vacant w.e.f. 30.04.2020 after the retirement of Sh. Mehar Chand, Superintendent.

As per Haryana State Pollution Control Board (Group A, B, C & D) Service Regulations, 2004 and subsequent amendment thereof in this regard, the following mode of recruitment and experience is prescribed for promotion to the post of Superintendent:-

- (i) By promotion from amongst Deputy Superintendent having 2 years experience; or Assistant/Accountants having 9 year's experience as Assistant /Accountant.
- (ii) By transfer or deputation of an official already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India.

As per the Haryana State Pollution Control Board (Group A, B, C & D) Service Regulations, 2004, powers to relax any of the provisions in these regulations:-

• **Powers of relaxation :-**

Rule-17 of Haryana State Pollution Control Board (Group A, B, C & D) Service Regulation, 2004 prescribed the following power of relaxation of the provisions of these regulations:-

*"Where the Board is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these regulations with respect of any class or category of persons with the approval of Govt."*

As per record, Sh. Ramesh Kumar Ranga acquired the experience of approximately 08 years 08 months in the Board as Assistant and Deputy Superintendent, for which relaxation of 04 months is required. As per record, no disciplinary action and contemplated proceedings are pending against him.

Since, the Board is competent to take a view to relax the experience criteria as per provision prescribed under Rule-17 of Service Regulations, 2004, hence, before sending the case to Government, the case of Sh. Ramesh Kumar Ranga, Deputy Superintendent for grant of relaxation in experience of 04 months is being placed before the Board of Directors for approval, so that case may be sent to the Government for further approval please.

Appointment of Board Analyst in  
Haryana State Pollution Control Board.

It is submitted that the Haryana State Pollution Control Board has established 04 laboratories at Panchkula, Hisar, Gurugram and Faridabad. Section 53 of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 provided that the State Board may, by notification in the official gazette and with the approval of the State Govt. appoint Board Analyst. Such reports of State Board Analyst are used as evidence. For appointment of Board Analyst following qualification for Board Analyst under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Rules, 1978 and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Rules, 1983 has been prescribed.

**Water (Prevention and Control Pollution) Rules, 1978**

**35A. Qualification of Board Analyst-section 53(3)**

A Board analyst shall be a person who-

- a. Is a M.Sc. in Chemistry or has bachelor Degree in Chemical Engineer or in Chemical bio Engineering; and
- b. Has practical experience of not less than five years in the analysis of water sewage or industrial waster in the analysis of water sewage or industrial wastes in the analysis of water sewage or industrial wastes in teaching or research or in Government laboratory.

**Air (Prevention and Control Pollution) Rules, 1983**

**22. Qualification of Government/ State Board Analyst, Section 29(1) and (2)**

At least, II Class M.Sc. in basic Sciences of Life Sciences or Earth Sciences with three years experience in environmental quality management.

There is shortage of Board Analyst in the Board and it is urgently required to appoint Board Analyst for the purpose of above Acts & Rules.

Smt. Neeraj Bala presently posted as Scientist-B may be appointed as Board Analyst under Water and Air Act. Her details regarding qualification and experience are as under:-

Smt. Neeraj Bala, Scientist 'B' is eligible for appointment as Board Analyst under Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

As per Rule 35(A) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Rules, 1978 read with section 53(3) of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Rule 22 of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Rules, 1983 read with Section 29 (1) & (2) of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 provides that State Board may, by notification in official Gazette, and with the approval of government appoint such person as it thinks fit and having prescribed qualifications. Therefore, the matter to appoint Smt. Neeraj Bala, Scientist 'B' as Board Analyst under the above acts is placed before the Board for consideration and approval so that the case may be sent to the government for further approval please.
