Whereas it has come to the notice of the Government that some of the Common Bio Medical Waste Treatment Facilities (CBWTFs) have recently hiked their charges considerably, without any justifiable reasons and not following due procedure and consultation, for the treatment of Bio Medical Waste (BMW) of Health Care Facilities (HCFs) which have entered into

Whereas as per the provisions of the Guidelines of CBWTFs, issued by Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), the revision of the treatment charges has to be done by the State Advisory Committee, once in a year, and it should be done based on Wholesale Price Index (WPI) or Consumer Price Index (CPI), in consultation with the concerned State Pollution Control Board, local Medical Association and the representatives of the CBWTF Association; and,

Whereas the State Advisory Committee for the State of Haryana is being constituted by the Government, as per the provisions of Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 and is

The above mentioned complaints have been examined by the Government in consultation with Haryana State Pollution Control Board (HSPCB) and it is hereby ordered that all the CBWTFs shall roll back their present charges to the rates which were charged on 01.04.2017, with immediate effect, till a decision is taken in this matter at Government level.
