Sandeep Singh, Regional Officer, Faridabad, HSPCB, first welcomed and greeted everyone and asked for the permission to start the hearing from the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad. After receiving the permission, Sandeep Singh invited Mr. Harendra Kumar, representative of EIA Consultant, to brief and present the EIA study to everyone about the project.

Mr. Harendra Kumar, representative of EIA Consultant conveyed his greetings and presented the Project Synopsis and EIA study with a Power Point Presentation to the officers and public present in the occasion. He briefed about the salient features of the project, the baseline observations, impacts and mitigation measures undertaken and proposed by the project proponent. The essence of the presentation are:

 Letter of Intent (LOI) was issued by the Director Mines & Geology Haryana vide letter no. DMG/HY/Mahawatpur-Bhaskola/Faridabad/2024/2877 dated 14-06-2024 for Mining of Sand (Minor Mineral) in Mahawatpur-Bhaskola Unit, comprising Lalpur, Mahawatpur, Maujmabad and Bhaskola villages over an area of 134.40 acres (53.76 hectares) in district Faridabad, Haryana for a period of 09 years.



- The proposed project involves mining of minor mineral i.e. sand from the bed of river Yamuna, at Village- Lalpur, Mahawatpur, Maujmabad and Bhaskola, Tehsil & District- Faridabad, Haryana from an auctioned area of 134.40 acres (53.76 ha).
- The capital cost for the project will be Rs. 16.65 Crores including proposed lease area and machinery will be hired on contract bases.
- 4. The applicant, applied for environment clearance to Haryana State Environmental Impact Assessment Authority (Haryana SEIAA) on date 15.09.2024 (online) vide proposal no. SIA/HR/MIN/496786/2024 to obtain "Terms of Reference" (ToR). The standard ToR was issued by State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority; Haryana vide TOR Identification No. TO24B0107HR5745538N dated 20.09.2024. The proponent was also asked to conduct the public hearing on this project. Accordingly, the public hearing was carried out on dated 18-02-2025 at Village Mahawatpur, Faridabad.
- 5. It was presented that the mine location does not fall under any sensitive zone.
- 6. The mining is proposed through an opencast mechanized method without drilling and blasting.
- 7. Highest elevation in riverbed at extreme north end is 141.96 mRL and bank top level is 145.77 mRL whereas the levels at the extreme south end in riverbed is 136.96 mRL and Riverbank top is 141.19 mRL. The Yamuna River flows from N to S direction in Lalpur, Mahawatpur, Mauimabad, Bhaskola revenue villages.
- The minor mineral i.e. sand is proposed to be excavated by Light weight excavators and will also be used for loading of mineral in tippers.
- 9. The loading of the mineral shall be mechanical while transport of mineral from riverbed shall be done by private trucks/tippers operators (which should be covered by tirpal).
- Total lease area is replenishable yearly.
- 11. Mineral extraction will be done for a period of about 280 days in a year.
- The total water requirement is 28.40 KLD as estimated. 9.60 KLD for Dust Suppression, 13.10 KLD for Greenbelt / Plantation & 5.80 KLD for Domestic Requirement. Water will be supplied by private water tanker.
- 13. It is proposed to plant 13,100 nos. of plantation on riverbank bunds, ancillary area & connected haul road with consultation of local administration and Forest department.
- Adequate measures will be adopted to minimize the impact of pollutants generated from mining activities.
- 15. Water sprinkling and plantation on haul roads shall be done for controlling Air Pollution.
- 16. An amount of Rs. 33.30 lakhs shall be incurred for improvement of biological environment of area which will include survey for presence of Schedule Wildlife as per Indian Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 and amendments thereof; tree plantation; training and awareness camps and procurement of GPS, Camera Traps etc.
- 17. A budget of Rs. 20.00 Lakhs has also been earmarked under Environment and Social Responsibility for the project. This includes health check-up camps; Insurance cover to workers; assistance to local schools, panchayat; improvement of toilets and drinking water facilities and assistance to Self Help groups etc.
- 18. For the Environmental Management Plan, a budget of Rs. 18.00 Lakhs as a capital cost and Rs. 5.30 Lakhs as a recurring cost has been earmarked for the protection of the environment. The activities include are monitoring of Air, Noise, Water pollution; water sprinkling, fencing for plantation; rainwater harvesting; roads repair and maintenance and survey for sedimentation in riverbed.

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19. It was also mentioned that the amount of Rs. 1.05 crores/annum (i.e. 10% of lease amount/annum) for 09 years shall be deposited to the DC Office, Faridabad and the panchayat of Lalpur, Mahawatpur, Maujmabad, Bhaskola villages may approach DC office and request for this amount for development works in the village.

Thereafter, public opinion on environmental issues due to the proposed mining project was sought. Sandeep Singh, Regional officer, Faridabad, HSPCB asked the public to submit their queries/ suggestions.

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


