Mrs. Harmanpreet Kaur, conveyed her invitation to the Deputy Commissioner, Regional Officer, Mining Officer and Public Health Department Officers and Tehsildar for their august presence at the Public Hearing. She has presented the Project Synopsis and EIA study with a PowerPoint Presentation to the public present at the occasion. She has briefed about the salient features of the project, the baseline observations, impacts and mitigation measures undertaken and proposed by the project proponent. The essence of her presentation consists:

- 1. The proposed project involves mining of mineral i.e. sand from the bed of river Yamuna, at a part of Village- Bega Tehsil- Ganaur & District: Sonipat, State: Haryana from an auctioned area of 51.15 Ha.
- 2. The total cost of the project is Rs. 3.89 Crores. Industry will also provide the employment to about 106 persons from the nearby area based on their eligibility.
- 3. The applicant, has applied for Environmental Clearance on 25.04.2024 at MoEFCC, GoI and the SEIAA, Haryana had considered the application and granted Terms of Reference (TOR), vide File No. SEAC/HR/2024/102 dated 30.08.2024 and also asked to conduct the public hearing on this project. Accordingly, the public hearing is being carried out today at this place.
- 4. It was presented that the mine location does not fall under any sensitive zone.
- 5. The mining proposed by opencast semi- mechanized method without drilling and blasting.
- 6. It will start from one end (higher level) to other end (lower level) phase wise/ bench wise going to the maximum depth of 3.0 m bgl or above ground water level whichever is less.
- 7. The minor mineral i.e. sand is proposed to be excavated by backhoe type excavator and directly loading in to trucks/dumpers & dispatch to market.
- 8. The loading of the mineral shall be mechanical while transport of mineral from river bed shall be done by tarpaulin covered private trucks/ dumper operators.
- 9. Water sprinklers will be used to mitigate the generation of dust.
- 10. Total lease area is replenishable yearly.
- 11. Mineral extraction will be done for a period of about 285 days in a year.
- 12. About 10.0 KLD approx. water will be required for Drinking & Dust Suppression / Plantation & Source: Tankers.
- 13. Out of 51.15 Ha lease area, 16.96 ha area will be covered under Greenbelt/Plantation. In consultation with village Panchayat, plantation will be done along the roads, in schools and public building and other social forestry programme.
- 14. Adequate measures will be adopted to minimize the impact of pollutants generated from mining activities.

Smt. Harman anticipated that the management will put all efforts to implement the suggestions given in EIA Report. There will not be any pollution problem from this mining. She then sought public opinion on the project and express willingness to clarify their queries. Smt. Harman, Consultant asked the public to submit their queries/ suggestions.

Regular monitoring of mining sites are now being done at State and Central level by the various responsible agencies.

99% of village roads of Sonipat District are now has been constructed, wherever roads are not constructed, will be covered under Mukhmantri Khet Sadak Yojna and will be maintained.
